Together as a class we decided our home topic should be:

How many of the following can you do:

Draw a picture of your house and tell me about where you live.	Choose one animal local to Amble and tell me about it. Where does it live? What does it eat? Don't forget to draw a picture too!	Tell me about a holiday you have been on. Can you add pictures too!
How can we protect our planet? Make a list of all the things we can recycle at home. Can you make a junk model with what you have?	Grow a plant from a bean or seed.
