Don't hesitate to pop in if you have any queries.





E-safety

It has come to our attention that more and more children are taking part in the online gaming world and in social media and are not adhering to the age restrictions of certain sites. The safety of our children is always of upmost importance to us and we will continue to teach children how to stay safe online. However, we can't do this alone as much of this activity tends to happen in the home.

If you are concerned about your child's online activity please talk to us at school or come along to the coffee afternoon and talk to the NSPCC experts. There is also useful advice on the NSPCC or CEOP website. Please continue to be aware of what your child is doing online and monitor their use closely.

Here are a few age restriction reminders:

Fortnite - 12+ (violence)

Roblox - 7+ (please be aware that the low age limit of Roblox does not mean it is 100% risk free).

Facebook - 13+ (The NSPCC deems Facebook a very high risk for violence and hatred, sexual harm and bullying).

Snapchat - 13+

Youtube - 13+ to have own account with a parental permission.

Instagram - 13+

Minecraft - 7+ - 13+ depending on which version you are playing.

Breakfast club

Our very popular breakfast club will continue to run from 8:10am for the sum of £1 per day. The children get the choice of cereal, toast or pastries and juice or water and can play with their friends until the start of the school day.

After school club- Monday to Thursday

We are offering an after school club that children can go to from the end of the school day until:

- 4:15pm for £3 per day
- 5:15pm including snack £6 per day
- 5:45pm including snack £8 per day

Children will have access to games, computers and crafts with opportunities for outdoor play-weather permitting. It will help us with staffing if we know in advance who would require a place. If you work shifts I can appreciate this will be hard to pre-book and we would try to accommodate any late requests.
