Now we should be getting a bit more fluent as it is the second time we are reading the book. Answer the questions about the story at the end of the book. Write the sentence 'Rag the Rat'</p>	<p>Topic - what do you notice? I have noticed that outside the world is changing again - it is lighter until after dinner, I can hear the birds in the morning and I can see flowers growing on my walks! This tells me it is nearly Spring! Can you go for a nature walk / have a look outside in your garden or yard. What do you notice now? How is it different to Winter time?</p> <p>Can you make a thought shower of what you notice and see about outside? Add what you know about Spring and about growing plants! Don't forget to share this on tapestry!</p>
