Learning log:

For the next few weeks our topic will be -

What lives under the sea?

How many of the following can you do:

Visit the local rock pools with your family - what creatures can you find? Do you know what any of them are?	Design a boat - see if it floats? Can you make two and race them?	Explore items in your house which float and sink. Make lists of the things which float and those which sink - what do you notice about them?
Visit the beach with your family - what sounds can you hear? Make a picture to show all the different things you could hear.	Tell me about your favourite under the sea story! Tell me why you like it. Can you retell it at home?	Can you make a beach picture? Can you use paint or pens? Perhaps you could use natural materials?
What creatures live under the sea? Can you draw a picture of three animals which love under the sea?	Go to the beach and make a piece of beach art! Can you use stones, shells and seaweed?	Find out about people who keep us safe at the beach such as the life boat, life guards and the coast guard!
