# <u>Uniform</u>

Our school uniform consists of:

- Jumper or cardigan in our school colour turquoise, with or without our school logo
- White/navy polo shirt, with or without our school logo
- Black or grey trousers/skirt
- Blue or yellow gingham dress
- Black or grey shorts
- Black school shoes

Jeans and denim shorts should not be worn for school.

For safety reasons, no jewellery should be worn to school except a single pair of stud earrings.

Children should come to school in their PE kits on these days. This comprises their school jumper/cardigan, a white/navy t-shirt and dark coloured shorts/tracksuit bottoms. Shoes should be trainers or sandshoes. Earrings should not be worn on PE days. Staff are unable to remove children's earrings or cover them. If the child is unable to remove the earrings themselves they should be sent to school with them suitably covered.

# School Nurse

We are very fortunate to have support in school from My School Health Nursing Services to support our families in school. This term we welcome Ciara who will offer a wide range of support from behaviour, bereavement, sleep, self-esteem and many other concerns that you may have. Ciara will visit the school fortnightly on a Monday afternoon and will meet with both children and/or parents. Please get in touch at any time of the year if you have any questions or if there is anything that you feel Ciara may be able to help with.

### **Attendance**

In the summer term, we published our new attendance documents which outline the expectations for school attendance. We worked closely with the other schools in the Coquet Partnership to ensure a greater level of consistency across schools in how we approach attendance. In line with the Local Authority's Attendance Strategy, we consider 97% attendance to be good attendance. The whole process is based around securing improvement and is intended to support families in ensuring that their children have the best possible attendance at school.
