Times of the school day - a reminder

In order to comply with the Department for Education's requirement to offer 32.5 hours of education in school a week, there will be a slight change to the start and finish times of the school day from September 2022.



The gates will be open and staff will welcome children onto the yard from 8:35am. The school day will start for all children at **8:45am** in the morning.

The gates to the playground will be locked at 8:45am. Any children arriving after this time must enter the building through the main entrance. Miss Nowak will record children arriving after this time.

At hometime, children will continue to line up on the yard with their teacher. Children are permitted to leave only when their adult is seen. The school day will finish for all children at <u>3:15pm</u>. Children who attend full time nursery will continue to finish at 3pm.

Please can you ensure that you update school with any new details, e.g. phone numbers, home addresses, email addresses. It is essential that we can make contact in case of an emergency.
