Draw or stick on legs, cut out a diamond shape and fold in half to make a beak. Draw or paint on eyes!</p>

Add food colour or glitter if you have any. Roll into egg shapes. Stick a little egg shape onto a big one and make your chick. Roll the dough into a flat circle, next shape the dough into a nest by pressing into your hand. Sit your eggs and chicks in your basket. Simple dough can be made with a cup plain flour, half a cup of salt, a teaspoon of any cooking oil. Gradually add warm water and mix.</p>
