## Welcome meetings

All parents and carers are warmly invited to come to a welcome meeting hosted by your child's class teacher. It will be at the end of the school day for 15 minutes, starting at **3pm**. The **year two meeting starts at 2:30pm** as we are going to discuss SATs tests! The aim of this is to set out expectations for the year and answer any questions you may have. If you can't make the meeting the children will also come home with a class information booklet containing the same expectations.

Literacy parent drop in - This term we will be offering you a chance to come and see your children working in a Literacy lesson. The children are going to demonstrate strategies for spelling, grammar, punctuation and handwriting and the teachers will be showing you how to help at home. The sessions will be run during the school day either first thing in the morning or the last session of the day. The dates are as following:

Year Two SATs parents meeting— This is a very important year for our year two pupils. All year two parents and carers are invited to hear more about their learning journey. We will share with you the expectations for the end of the year and explain the purpose of the end of year SATS (Standard Attainment Tests). We have extended the welcome meeting on September 11th to start from 2:30pm. If you can't make this date we will consider running a second meeting or inviting you to speak with the class teacher individually.

Year One Phonics parents meeting-All year one parents are invited to our phonics meeting. We will share with you the work we are doing in school and lots of fun resources and activities that you can do with your children at home. This will take place as a parent drop on September 24th at 9am.



We have decided to begin termly swim sessions for year groups in order to gain a longer lesson. The cost of swimming increased to £4 per week for 45 minutes lesson. Only two year groups will swim every week for one term on Wednesdays.

Year 3 and 4 will swim in the Autumn Term

Year 1 and 2 will swim in the Spring Term

Year 3 (half a term) and 4 and Reception (half a term) will swim in the summer term

Swimming starts again on **Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> September** for years 3 and 4. Please ensure you have your swimming kit and swimming money (£4) in a named envelope. Thank you.
