<p><u>History</u></p> <p>Talk to some grown-ups from your family and find out what they used to play with when they were your age. Draw or paint a picture of their favourite toy.</p>	<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>William Morris was an artist who lived in Victorian times. He was famous for his wallpaper designs. He would repeat the same shapes and pictures when creating his artwork, often using flowers and leaves in his designs. Can you create a wallpaper design using a repeating pattern like William Morris?</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>We are continuing to learn about properties of materials this term...</p> <p>Draw an everyday object e.g. a sofa, window, water bottle... Think about what it is made out of (is it glass, plastic, wood, metal?) and write some sentences to explain why the materials are suitable. Design a 'silly invention' e.g. a bridge made of paper or a teapot made of chocolate! What makes it a silly invention?</p>
<p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>Write about your favourite toy. What is it called? What does it look like? What does it do? How do you play with it?</p> <p>You can draw a picture to go with your writing.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p>  <p>https://play.ttrockstars.com/</p> <p>You will find your Times Table Rock Stars log in in your learning log.
