Playground

We are busy re-developing the willow area in school as we would like more play space for the children. We are chopping down the willow and we would ideally like to get rid of the walls that the willow grows from. Following First Aid training we have been given the following advice about inhalers:

Brown inhalers are a preventative medication and should be given by parents at home (usually once in the morning and again at night).

Blue inhalers are to be given in response to symptoms of asthma and will be given in school when required. This is usually indicated on the inhaler sticker given by the doctor eg "inhale 2 doses as needed."

If your doctor has given you different advice e.g. inhaler before physical activity or at a set time, we would need a medical note from the doctor explaining how to administer this.
